

5-Hour Pre-Licensing Online Course

This course is taught online via Zoom. Students must provide a photo of a valid New York State driver's permit (back view is also necessary if the address has been changed from original) by emailing streetskillsmoto@gmail.com. Students will receive a Zoom meeting code and password by 2 p.m. on the date of their scheduled course. Students are to interact with the instructor the entire course and be ready to answer direct questions or comments. Upon successful completion of the course, the certificate will be mailed to the student, who must sign the certificate upon receipt. Please note, certificates will not be issued immediately following the course. Please check and be sure we have a correct email address and phone number for you before the start of the class. The MV-278 Certificate students receive is good for one year from the date it is issued and is used to schedule the road test. In addition to the basics, students will leave with knowledge of skills and habits for a lifetime of safe driving. The course will not simply provide the minimum information to pass a road test, but highvalue techniques. Mr. DelVecchio, the instructor, has taught driving skills for many years and has developed a informative and engaging pre-licensing experience.



Winter Spring 2024 Driver Education Information

Gates Chili CSD will be offering our Driver Education Program in the winter/spring of 2024. 





Community Swim Program


