## Visit Colleges & Attend Open Houses

- Visit colleges between September-May (when colleges are in session)
  - Try to do one tour by end of Junior year
  - Schedule tours on college's websites
- Tours include: dorms, financial aid office, athletic facilities, admissions office, library, etc.
- Some colleges offer overnight programs- ask about this!
- Talk to students on campus about their experiences and opinions
