

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

What is an Upstander?

- One Friday per month, we focus on our school-wide initiative called "Upstanders" which promotes social-emotional learning and positive character and behaviors.
- We have a shared objective to encourage students to be their "best self" so they can interact and support each other with the Spartan Way in mind.
- This is accomplished through a blend of Upstander activities coordinated by the counseling department in collaboration with teachers and staff!



- Students are assigned lockers- but may also carry a bookbag throughout the school day.
- Locker shelves can be helpful in keeping materials organized.
- Locker decorations need to be kept to the interior and cannot include writing on locker or "taping" the inside of the locker.
- Students will be assigned a locker within their community hallway





May/June 2023

- The middle school counselors will "visit" fifth-grade students
- Every fifth-grader will have the opportunity to participate in a live tour of the Middle School.

End of August

Students will receive their class schedule and locker assignments in mail.

Class schedules will also be available in SchoolTool.

Week before school begins

Students and families can visit to practice lockers, pick up laptops, tour the school, and visit classrooms, cafeteria, and bus loading and unloading areas.
