
CLASSLINK


Provides all-in-one access to digital instructional tools and resources for students to continue their learning. Some resources would include eBooks, audiobooks, video education and other tools teachers use in the classroom. Students sign on and access ClassLink using their assigned username and password.

Brings together assessment management to improve student performance, foster collaboration and personalized learning.
