Getting the most from your tutoring sessions

Stuck on your homework?

Start a session with a tutor.

- → Type out the question you need help with into the bar on your dashboard.
- → Or click "Ask a tutor" underneath the subject you need help with.

If the tutor asks:

"What have you tried so far?" or "Where do you think we should start?"

- → If you know what your first step is, let the tutor know.
- → Say "this is my work so far" then upload, draw, or type what you've done.
- → "I haven't tried anything, I haven't started yet."
- → "I'm confused about this problem."

"What did you learn about this in class?"

- → Send a picture or screenshot of your notes.
- → "I don't remember learning this in class."

How do you begin?

Tell the tutor what you need help with.

PAPER

- → Say "Hi! I'm in _____ grade, I need help with _____."
- → "Hi, I was absent when my teacher taught _____."

If you're still stuck:

Let the tutor know that you still need their help.

- → Say "Could you explain another way?"
- → Ask "Can you draw it out for me?"
- → Type "I'm not following. Can you try again?"
- → Say "I'm not sure what to do next."

Key Reminders

- → Remember to say hello
- → Tutors are real people! Be kind :)
- → If you do not get a response right away, don't stress. The tutor will be right with you.
