Federal Funds Update



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2023-24 Federal Funds Update

Grant-specific statuses:

- CRRSA: Approved, Spent, Claimed, Funded
- ARP: Approved, Spending
- ARP Set-Aside: Approved, Spending
- FEMA: Submitted, half received

2023-24 Federal Funds Update

As reported via BOE Finance, Facility, and Audit Committee updates:

- Rooftop HVAC units that were in the CRRSA Plan could not be delivered in time to meet the spending deadline
- Funds for furniture were swapped out of the ARP Funds in exchange for the HVAC units to meet the ARP spending deadline.

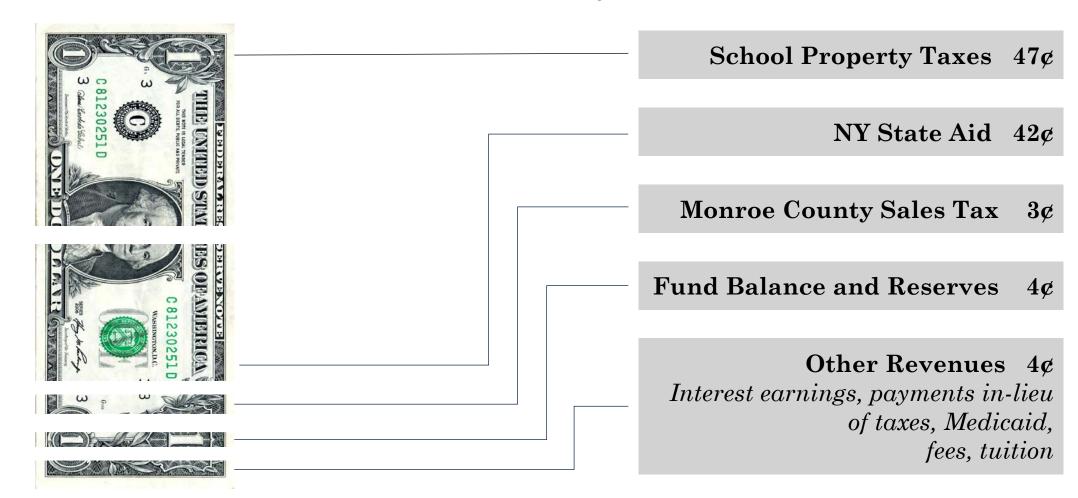
Revenue Estimates



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Carrent Year: Revenue Budget Breakdown



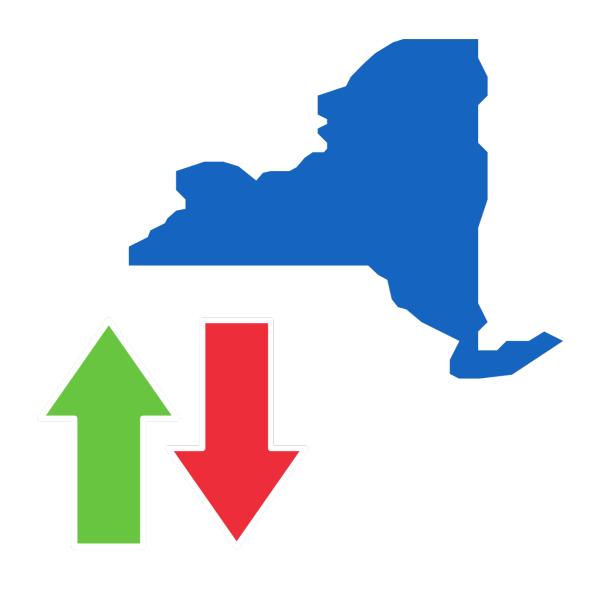


2023-24 State Aid

Adopted Budget: \$55,351,646

On track and in good shape.

Will receive less in state aid than budgeted, however, we have adjusted appropriated fund balance to account for difference.





State Aid: 2024-25

- Executive Proposal:
 - Released January 16, 2024
- Increase to School Aid
 - \$35.3 Million total
 - Increase of \$825 Million (2.39%)
- Hold Harmless Concerns

State Aid - Final Thoughts

- Estimated net aid increase of \$349,823
- Uncertainty surrounding final aid estimates
- Building Aid is stable
- Transportation Aid increase is good
- Continued cost shifting to BOCES







Breaking Budget News



There are three expiring Payments in Lieu of Taxes (PILOT) agreements within the Town of Chili:

> Wegmans: \$ 1,458,933

> Pontarelli: 37,465

> TOTAL: \$ 1,496,398

This means that we will no longer receive these payments through the PILOT agreement.





Breaking Budget News



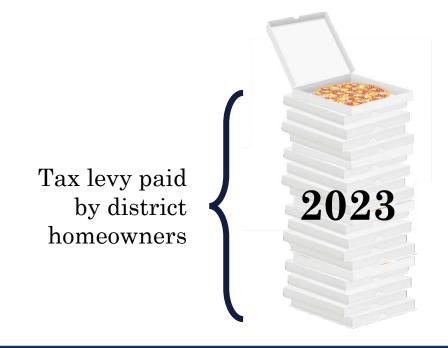
Therefore, the tax cap calculation increases the total levy by the decrease in PILOT payments to be received.

But this doesn't mean your taxes go up by this difference!

This additional taxation is distributed across the increased assessments that are coming back onto to the tax rolls.

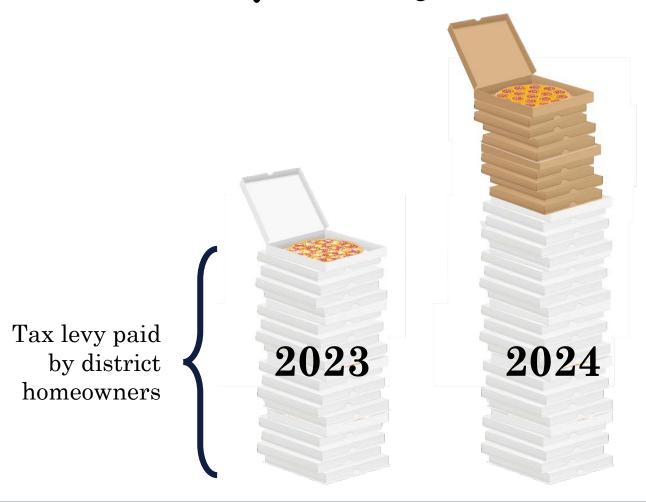

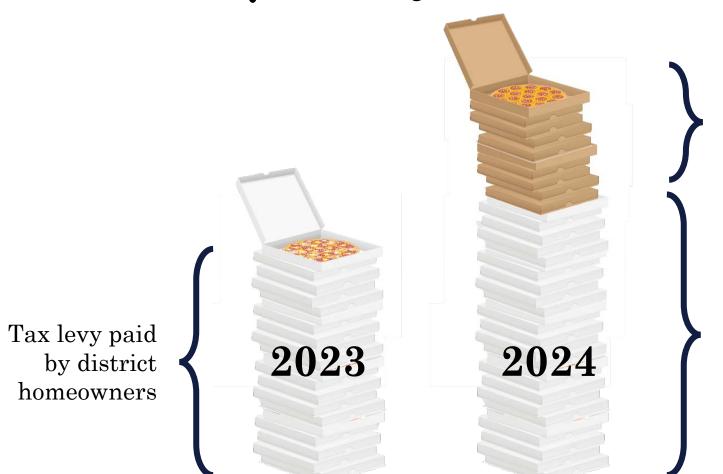

Breaking Budget News



So, now what?

When we communicate about the budget, we will focus on tax rate more than tax levy increase.

Why?

The true value tax rate percentage increase will be much lower than the tax levy percentage increase.



Tax Levy Limit

- CPI-U: 3.2%... Capped at 2.0%
- Tax base growth factor: 1.0068 (0.68%)
- Capital exclusion change: estimated awaiting final state aid snapshot: +\$178,507
- PILOTS decrease
 - From \$2,624,782 to \$1,468,802
 - Difference \$(1,155,980)
- Due March 1, 2024







Other Revenues

- Monroe County Sales Tax
- Facilities use, continuing education, fees, etc.
- Medicaid reimbursement
- All other stable
