### Tax Levy Limit

- CPI-U: 8.0% —— Capped at 2%
- Tax base growth factor: 1.0069 (0.69%)
- Capital Exclusion: +\$230,969 (0.40%)
- PILOTs: +\$44,782 (0.08%)

#### Electric buses!



- District has now been awarded all five (5) of the \$200,000 grants by NYSERDA
- All five (5) buses have been delivered and are not in service





### Bus Replacement Philosophy

To maintain a six-year bus replacement schedule, ensuring the highest of safety standards, as well as preserving long-term cost-savings.






#### Bus Replacement Considerations

- We typically replace buses at 6 years (see next slide)
- We typically replace 15 buses per year.
- Costs have increased by over \$23,000/bus
- We will plan to replace one less bus next year









#### Buses to be replaced

- One (1) 35-passenger wheelchair bus
- Ten (13) 66-passenger buses



Est. Trade-in value: \$366,000

#### Bus Replacement Totals

Total new buses = 14

Total cost = \$2,295,330

Estimated trade-in value for 14 buses = (\$366,000)

TOTAL = \$1,929,330

For every dollar spent, Gates Chili receives approximately 75 cents in reimbursement from New York State
