Here are a few suggestions of activities that your child could complete that doesn't require the internet or an electronic device.

- ★ Create a reading bingo board- have kids fill in ideas for activities for the squares (reading aloud to someone, having someone read to them, read on the couch, reading with a snack, read using a flashlight are just some ideas)
 - ★ Create a reading tent/fort to read in
- ★ Write a story cooperatively- one person picks the setting, another picks a character, etc.
 - ★ Write a letter to someone
 - ★ Bake something following a recipe
- ★ Go on an indoor scavenger hunt: Find something that starts with each letter of the alphabet.
 - ★ Play a board game together. Work on taking turns, how to lose and how to win graciously.
- ★ Practice math facts! Give your child some multiplication facts by either writing them down or just saying them.
- ★ Learn a new vocabulary word each day and try to use them throughout the day.
 - ★ Write a poem for the library poetry contest
 - ★ Go outside and explore. Look for different trees, plants, and animals.
 - ★ Keep a journal of what this experience has been like while not in school
