


Importing bookmarks/favorites from Internet Explorer, and turning on favorites bar

Edge


- 1) Click the 3 dots and go to settings



- 2) Click



- 3) Here you can turn your favorites bar on, or import your favorites from a different browser.




Chrome

- 1) Click the 3 dots, and go to settings.



- 2) Here you can turn on your bookmarks bar




- 3) Or import your bookmarks

By turning on your favorites/bookmarks bar, you will have a space below your address bar, where you can place frequently used bookmarks. This can be a **huge** timesaver.

Adding favorites to the favorite/bookmark bar


Edge

- 1) Go to a website you would like to add to the favorites bar. (Example: webmail.gateschili.org)
- 2) Click the star in the address bar
- 3) Type in a "friendly name"
- 4) Make sure to choose **Favorites Bar**
- 5) You can create a folder if you want
- 6) Click add



Chrome

- 1) Go to a website you would like to add to the favorites bar. (Example: webmail.gateschili.org)
- 2) Click the star in the address bar
- 3) Type in a "friendly name"
- 4) Choose **Bookmarks bar**
- 5) You can create a new folder using the same drop down menu
- 6) Click Done



If you are familiar with the icon for a website, you can delete the text so only the icon shows up. It will save you space so that you can add more favorites/bookmarks to the favorites/bookmarks bar.
