

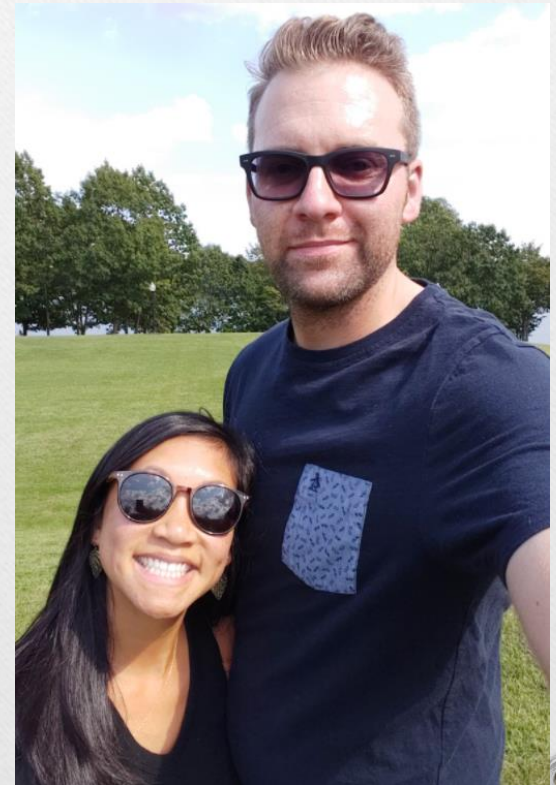

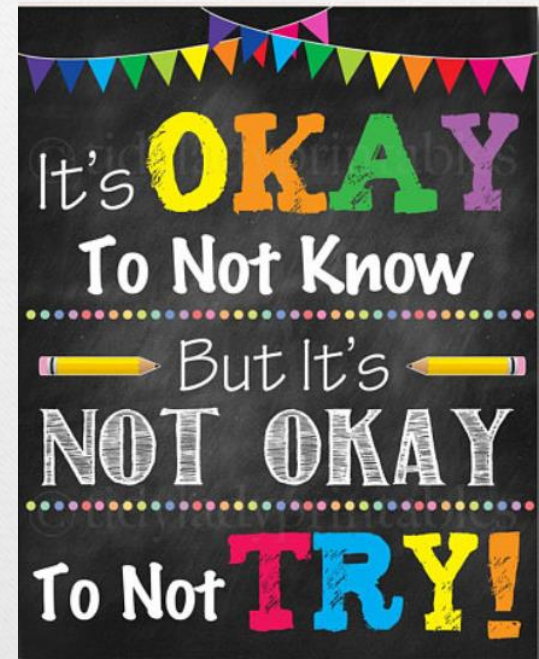

Unit 1: Reading Growth Spurt

- Read series of books by the same author

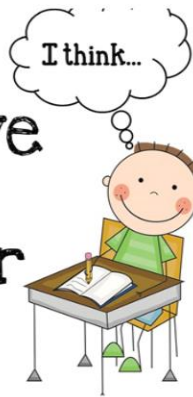

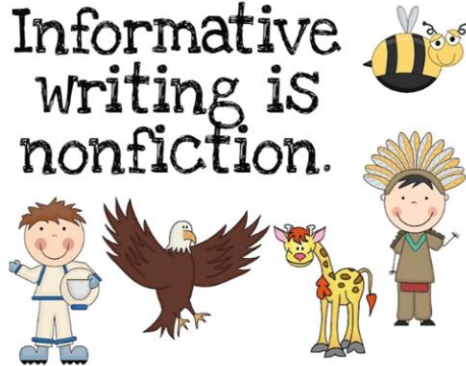

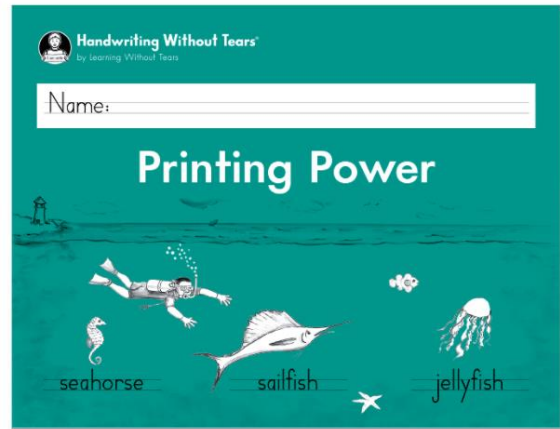
