

English as a New Language

English as a New Language or English to Speakers of other Languages is a service provided to help students who speak another language at home develop proficiency in English. At the same time, ENL teachers help students celebrate their diverse cultures and languages.



English Language Learners

English Language Learners (ELLs) are students who...


- scored Entering to Expanding on the NYSITELL or NYSESLAT
- received ENL services at a previous school
- experience another language at home



NYSITELL and NYSESLAT

NYSITELL (New York State Identification Test for English Language Learners) – given when a child first enters a NYS school district to identify if they are entitled to ENL services

NYSESLAT (New York State English as a Second Language Achievement Test) – given every spring to determine if a student will continue with services



Exiting ENL

Students who score Commanding on the NYSESLAT are no longer ELLs.

They will continue to receive ENL services for two more years.



English Language Proficiency Levels

- Entering 360 minutes a week
- Emerging 360 minutes a week
- Transitioning 180 minutes a week
- Expanding 180 minutes a week
- Commanding 90 minutes a week for 2 more years

^{*}Students who did not take the 2020 OR 2021 NYSESLAT will remain at their 2019 level.


