- Students then have the opportunity to work with other students in cooperative play.









Figuring Out Why?

When teaching students to become problem solvers, we also teach them how to solve problems when it is difficult to make good choices.

This is a sheet we usually give students to fill out before we conference with them so they can have time to reflect on what happened.

Depending on the severity of the choice the students make, parents will be notified. Usually after three Stop and Think sheets we will contact you.




R.E.D Folders are checked every morning. Students choose a new book to read that night.
