



Winter-Spring 2023 Driver **Education Information**

The Gates Chili School District will be offering our Driver Education Program in the Winter-Spring of 2023. We will offer one session with two lecture options on Tuesday or Sunday and a variety of drive times including M/W after school, Sat afternoons, and Sundays all day. Classes will start around Jan. 8 and will end on or around May 14. Students must be 16 years old, enrolled at a high school and be in good standing. Students must also hold a valid NYS permit prior to the start of the program. This program provides 16 sessions of lecture and 16 sessions of driving with a certified instructor. Practice driving with an adult will also need to occur prior and during the program. Is it time to get your Learner's Permit? The NYS Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) now allows students to take the Driver's License knowledge test online (on their own) or at their high school. Participation in this program should drastically reduce the time spent at the DMV office. After passing the exam you will be given the paperwork needed to take to the DMV to apply for your permit. The fee for this exam is in addition to any fees required by DMV. Students can take this permit test any time following their 15th birthday. 

Community Swim Program


