PARKING POLICY RULES AND REGULATIONS



The student must maintain good school attendance, punctuality and demonstrate the Spartan Way at all times. Students who are chronically tardy will have their driving privileges suspended or revoked.



Parking permits must be properly displayed and visible on the rear-view mirror at all times while on school property. Permits lost, damaged or stolen must be reported to the Security office.



All provisions of the New York State Motor Vehicle and Traffic Laws must be obeyed.



Drivers of a motor vehicle on school property must obey all posted signs and security directives while driving in a safe, lawful manner.



The student must park in the West Lot, west of the yellow line. (In front of the Field House)



Student will be assigned a parking spot. This spot will be numbered. Student must park in this spot only.



No student is to be in the parking lot or in any car during school hours unless written permission has first been obtained from the Grade Level Administrator or Security Office.



All vehicles are subject to search at any time.



Gates Chili does not have an open campus and students may not leave campus without parental permission during the school day.



We have read all the rules outlined above and understand that failure to comply with these rules and regulations may result in the following: disciplinary action from the Grade Level Administrator and/or Security Supervisor, cancellation of the student parking permit.



Failure to conform to our regulations may result in the vehicle being towed at driver's expense and revocation of parking privileges.

NOTE: The School District is not responsible for any items lost, stolen, or damaged. The School District is not liable for any damage to a vehicle while parked on School District property.
