Finishes are coming along nicely, and the building is really taking shape.

#### Potential Impacts to Phase 1.3:

• Due to the Corona Virus, complications have arisen in terms of availability of man power and materials. We are working closely with all prime contractors and subcontractors to ensure the progression of the project. As it stands today, we are still on schedule to turn over the Middle School at the end of August. Punch list will continue into September.

# **Phase 1.3 Middle School**

#### **Work Completed in July**

- All of the casework is complete throughout the building .
- 95% of all of the lockers are installed.
- 99% of all ceramic wall tile is complete throughout the building.
- All air handling equipment is on site.
- Demolition of alternate #3 is complete.

#### **Projected Work for August**

- Finishes in the core area which include: painting, trim, casework, and ceilings. These will be ongoing for a couple months.
- Flooring is underway in the core area.
- Ceilings will be wrapping up.
- The remainder of the air handler equipment will be up and running by August 20th.







So far all aspects of this project are progressing nicely. To date there is 7.2 miles of underground piping, 810 cy of concrete, and 400 tons of rebar.

#### **Work Completed in July**


- Building backfill is complete.
- Proscenium columns have been poured.
- Mechanical trade work in the tunnels is complete.
- Stage house wall is 95% complete.

### **Projected Work for August**

- Masons will continue laying block for a couple months.
- Mechanical and electrical trades are working with the mason for any wall penetrations and/or items needed to be placed in the walls.
- Structural steel contractor should be mobilizing by the end of the month.
- Underground chiller piping will begin.

Upon site layout and underground utilities location before digging, we realized the survey was off by 25'. This puts the water main in the way of building foundations.

#### **Work Completed in July**


- Demolition at Neil Armstrong and Walt Disney is complete.
