

PROCEDURES FOR DROPPING OFF & PICKING UP YOUR STUDENT

Student Drop-Off

Students may be dropped off at school between 8:50 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. Students who are dropped off at this time do not need to be signed in at the main office. When dropping off or picking up students, you must use the entrance off of Laredo Drive. Drop your child off in the side parking lot. Students may walk up the sidewalk to the side entrance to enter school.

Here's what to expect when you come to pick your child up from Brasser:

- If you are picking your child up during the school day: You will need to park and enter our main office foyer where you will be asked to sign out your child and to show Identification. Only parents/guardians are allowed to sign a child out during the day. Those that are on our emergency contacts may pick the students up at the end of the day without a note.
- If you are picking your child up after school: Please let the office know by noon that your child will be picked up. If you are unable to contact the office ahead of time, you will not enter the pick-up line; you will need to park and enter through the main office foyer.

If the office knows you will be picking up your child, please line up in your car in the lower parking lot extending onto Laredo drive by 3:15. Students will begin being released by 3:20. You will need to show proper ID for us to release your child. You will not need to leave your car.

VISITOR PROCEDURE

We look forward to inviting families to school for various activities throughout the year.

- For first-time access your **driver's license or other form of valid government issued photo ID** will need to be scanned. You will be required to show your ID on subsequent visits, but it will not need to be scanned again.
- After approval, an ID badge will be printed, which you will be required to wear for the duration of your visit.
- After your business in the school is concluded, you will return to the place of check-in in order to check out.
