
NYS Citizen Disaster Preparedness Program

Driver Education

Gates Chili will be offering its Driver Education Program in person. We will offer two sessions with a variety of drive times. The first group will take place June 26-30, July 5-7, and 24-Aug. 2. The second group take place July 10-14, 17-21 and Aug. 3-10.

Students must be 16 years of age, hold a valid NYS permit, be enrolled in high school, and be in good standing. We offer two date options for students. This program provides 16 sessions of lecture and 16 sessions of driving with an instructor. Practice driving with an adult will also need to occur prior and during the program. Registration is done by birthdate lottery and will be available in mid- April. The price will be \$500 for in-district attendees and \$575 for out-of-district participants. Payment plans are available. Some details may be subject to change.

Five-Hour Pre-licensing Course ONLINE

This course is taught via an online video session. Students must provide a photo of a valid NYS DMV drivers permit (back view is also necessary if the address has been changed from original) by emailing <code>jon@streetskills.net</code>

Students will receive a meeting code and password to attend the Zoom conference by 2 p.m. on the date of their scheduled course. Students are to interact with the instructor the entire course and be ready to answer direct questions or comments. Upon successful completion of the course the certificate will be mailed to the student and the student must sign the certificate upon receipt. Please note certificates will not be issued immediately following the course. Please check and be sure we have a correct email, address, and phone number for you before the start of the class. The MV-278 Certificate students receive is good for one year from the date it is issued and is used to schedule the road test. In addition to the basics, students will leave with knowledge of skills and habits for a lifetime of safe driving. The course will not simply provide the minimum information to pass a road test, but high-value techniques. Mr. DelVecchio, the instructor has taught auto driving skills for many years and has developed a informative and engaging prelicensing experience.

Community Swim Program


